

## **Rules of the contest "Promotion of new talents"**

### **Article 1 : Purpose of the contest**

Art and craft gallery « Art et Artisanat du Monde » is organising a contest for amateur painters who are members of collective art courses.  
The theme of the contest is "The water".

### **Article 2 : How to participate**

Who can participate : Members of collective art courses, must be an amateur painter with a teacher.  
At least 4 members of the art course must participate and a minimum of 5 works in total shall be presented.

### **Article 3 : Accepted works**

Collective art courses can only exhibit works created by their members. Works shall be personal creation (no copies) and pictures of the works shall be the sole property of the exhibitor (including copyrights).

Art et Artisanat du Monde may not accept some candidates if works proposed have no link with the theme of the contest or if works are only copies of older works.

In this case, the subscription to the contest will be cancelled and the fees refunded (Nevertheless, Art et Artisanat du Monde will keep the amount corresponding to expenses already engaged).

### **Article 4 : Contest subscription and pictures reception**

Subscription folder, including pictures of works proposed, must be sent before the 20th of May 2009.  
Paper copies or electronic files (format readable on PC with Word or Open office) are accepted.

Art et Artisanat du Monde website will exhibit only the pictures provided. Paper or electronic copies are accepted (no extra fee for paper copies).

Art et Artisanat du Monde can decide to allow further time to send pictures.

By work exhibited :

- Up to 2 pictures can be sent.
- A fee of 2€ will be paid for each work presented.

No Fee for the group subscription

## **Article 5 : Works exhibition**

On the website, each art course will be presented on one page with one picture and a small text if provided on time to Art et Artisanat du Monde.

Each work will be presented with his title and the name (or pseudonym) of the author.

A visitor's book will be opened for each group to allow comments from visitors. Copy of visitors comments will be sent to the art course.

For the 10 first groups the exhibition duration will be extended (6 additional months starting 15<sup>th</sup> of July 2009).

## **Article 6 : Votes**

Votes are open from 25<sup>th</sup> of May to 25<sup>th</sup> of June 2009.

Votes for each work will be cumulated for each art course.

A vote will be validated if and only if :

- Voter must be a physical person
- Voter must provide a valid personal E-mail address
- Voter can vote only once for one work but can vote for several ones as long as votes are open and even if works are from the same art course (3 maximum per group).

Art et Artisanat du Monde has the right to prolonge the voting period if considered necessary (late subscriptions arrival for instance).

After the contest, voters will receive the monthly newsletter from Art et Artisanat du Monde. They can cancel this subscription to the newsletter on request by E-mail.

## **Article 7 : Results**

Winners will be designated the 30<sup>th</sup> of June.

Winners will be the art course having collected the higher number of vote, under the conditions described above.

Moreover, the 10 first art courses having collected the higher number of votes will be offered to exhibit 6 months on Art et Artisanat du Monde website.

Results of the contest will be published on Art et Artisanat du Monde website on the 15<sup>th</sup> of July 2009 (Name of winners and percentage of votes).

## **Article 8 : Copy rights and use of works image**

Any exhibitor accepting to participate in this contest accepts that Art et Artisanant du Monde can freely use pictures of their works to promote the website without any limitation on time and location.

**Article 9 : Contest cancellation**

Art et Artisanant du Monde can cancel the contest if less than 5 art courses participate.  
In such a case, Art et Artisanant du Monde will refund all fees.

**Article 10 : Use of data collected**

Data collected will not be given or sold to other company.
